Expedition Overview

At 8,188 meters (26,864 feet), Mt. Cho Oyu is the **6th highest mountain** in the world. Its name means “**Turquoise Goddess**,” reflecting its majestic appearance. Located on the border of **Tibet and Nepal**, Cho Oyu is often considered one of the **more accessible 8,000-meter peaks**, making it a preferred choice for first-time high-altitude climbers.

Though technically less demanding via the Northwest Ridge, climbers must be prepared for **extreme altitude, cold temperatures, and steep ice walls**.
